1970 Dodge Challenger 440 Six Pack


Kevin Zipkey has us doing a full rotisserie resto on his 1970 440 Six Pack Challenger and personalizing it a bit too. We have a body shell restored and ready for finally primer coats. The final finish will be in B5 Blue Metallic with black interior and black vinyl top. The engine was rebuilt and Dyno tested by Mike Mastin. Exhaust will be handled by a set of TTI headers with dual exhaust tips out the back of the car.

Jamie Passon is handling the parts for the 4 speed transmission conversion and setting it up with his over-drive 4th gear. The old Caddy is taking shape as the metal work phase comes to a close and the body work continues. The body has been off the rotisserie and back on the frame recently to fit all the sheet metal and check panel gaps/fitment while Jake continued patching up the quarter panels, rocker panels, and lower fenders. The body work is in motion now. Soon it will come back apart and return to the rotisserie for another round of work and final finish the underbody.


